- Forum for technical discussion about ongoing (unpublished) science

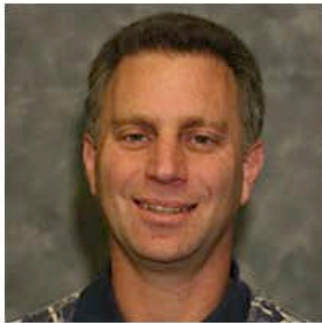
